

Wesley Lakes Pool Rules
Amenity Hours: 10:00 AM-9:00PM

- Homeowners must have their pool key fob with them while in the pool area.
- The pool is for use by dues paying members and their non-resident guests. Homeowners must be present at the pool with their guest at all times.
- Anyone that is using the pool without proper authorization will be removed from the grounds and criminal charges may follow.
- Children 15 and under must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) at all times while in the pool area.
- The HOA reserves the right to refuse entry into the pool without proper supervision of minors.
- The pool gate must be closed at all times. DO NOT prop the gate open or give your key fob to others, those found propping the gate open or giving the key fob to others will have pass and rights suspended
- Persons with skin, eye, ear or nasal infections or open sores and cuts, or communicable diseases should not enter the pool
- Children, 3 years old and younger, as well as any child not potty trained must wear swimming diapers, snug fitting plastic pants or water resistant swim diapers (such as Little Swimmers by Huggies). Regular diapers are NOT allowed in the pool at any time.
- No swimming allowed during heavy rain or when thunder and lightning can be heard. If at any time there is lightning or thunder, everyone is to get out of the pool immediately.
- No skateboards, bicycles, roller blades, etc. are allowed in pool area.
- No spitting, spouting of water, blowing nose, etc. are allowed in pool area.
- No running, dunking, horse or roughhouse play.
- No glass or breakable objects; NO alcoholic beverages or SMOKING OF ANY KIND is allowed in or around the pool area.
- No food, drink or wrappers shall be permitted within 10 feet of swimming pool.
- Swimwear is required; No cutoff jeans.
- No large flotation devices allowed on busy days.
- No profane or abusive language will be tolerated.
- Radios/CD/tape players should be played at volumes that do not disturb others.
- Nudity is not tolerated in the pool area, children included.
- In the event of an emergency, please pick up red phone near the bathrooms; phone calls 911 immediately.
- Everyone must clean up after him/herself.
- Do not leave floats or pool toys in the pool. Personal items left in the pool will be disposed.
- No pets allowed inside fenced pool area.
- No throwing objects across pool.
- No grills allowed inside fenced pool area.
- Guests: Homeowners are limited to four (4) guests per home without prior approval from the Board of Directors.
- SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY!
- No weapons allowed in amenity areas (KNIVES, GUNS, ETC.)

PLEASE NOTE: The Health Department requires the pool to be closed for 24 hours if a fecal accident occurs in the pool. DO NOT enter the pool area anytime a closed sign is posted.

The above rules and regulations are for your safety and the safety of others, as well as, taking care of the amenities. Residents will be held financially responsible for any damage they or their nonresident guest may cause by not abiding by the rules. These charges will be assessed against your property.
